



Grand National Ayrshire Jackpot Calf Sale

RULES

1. The bidding is open to anyone. However, to be eligible for the Jackpot prizes, the calf must be registered solely in a junior breeder's name who resides anywhere in the world, boy or girl, under 21 years of age as of January 1st the year the animal is purchased.
2. Grand National Ayrshire Jackpot heifers will be auctioned each year in the National Convention Sale, the number being limited to six animals.
3. The heifers must be born from December 1st of the previous year through June 1st of the sale year.
4. Twenty-five percent of the sale price will be put into a jackpot which will be awarded in the form of cash prizes at the third National Convention Sale (three years) following the purchase of the heifers.
5. Prizes will be awarded on the first completed lactation up to 305 days on ME Energy Corrected Milk (ECM).
6. The prizes will be as follows:
First Prize: 60% of the jackpot
Second Prize: 30% of the jackpot
Third Prize 10% of the jackpot
7. Loss by death or transfer of ownership of any heifer before the record is completed eliminated that heifer and owner from competition.
8. The records of the heifers purchased in the Jackpot program must be completed in a herd on official test.
9. The official records of Rule 5 made by the heifers purchased must be submitted to the Secretary of the Ayrshire Breeders' Association at least one week prior to the sale.
